As members of the Frankston Wine & Food Society we share the responsibility to maintain the highest standards of conduct. On joining the Society, members acknowledge this Code and any Society's Rules and in particular to not behave in an unbecoming manner.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- offensive, discriminatory, racist, sexist, aggressive or otherwise inappropriate speech or actions towards any other person
- harassment and bullying
- unwanted physical contact
- drunk or disorderly conduct
- unsafe or unlawful conduct
- abuse of, or inappropriate conduct towards, staff at venues or other members and their guests

As a member of the Frankston Wine & Food Society, we ask you to review the Members Code and to abide by it at all times. If you have a guest attend with you, please ensure they also understand the Society's expectation of their conduct.

The Society allows for action to be taken when behaviour is contrary to the expectations set out in this Members Code

That action can include suspension or expulsion from the Society.
